Build your knitting skills one square at a time!

“Building Blocks” is a series of 12 fun patterns that will build your knitting skills. Starting with simple knit and purl stitches, your confidence will grow as you progress through several major knitting principles. Each block focuses on new stitches and techniques in a sequential fashion that “builds” upon the previously learned skill.

At the end of the series, you will be rewarded with an abundance of knitting know-how and 12 beautiful squares to assemble into a sampler afghan.’

Materials: 1400 yards of Aran or Worsted weight yarn, size 10 needles, plus pattern book.

### **Vodka Gimlet**

An open cardigan with simple embellishment and a narrow, delicate shawl collar. A beautiful slipped stitch detail creates a flattering “waist” on the open sweater, and is echoed on the collar and hem. A loose casual garment but with a more finished look that is easily adjusted for a great fit.

Materials: Worsted weight yarn, 1100-1600 yards, size 7 circular needles 32”

Cost: \$35 + materials

## **Lightwaves**

This shawl pattern provides a perfect project to use the wrap and turn technique to create wave-like rows of colors. Use gradient mini skein packs to achieve colors that blend and enhance the color scheme of your shawl.

Materials: One skein fingering or DK weight yarn, and corresponding sized mini skein pack. Size 6 or 7 32” circular needle.

Homework: Begin the project at home and be ready to start the short rows in class.

### **Glittens**

...neither glove nor mitten

Ever been frustrated because you couldn’t pick up your keys out of your purse while wearing mittens? Ever had cold hands in normal gloves? You’ve never tried knitting gloves because there are so few stitches on the needles while knitting the fingers? There is a solution! Combine the advantages of both gloves and mittens and you get...Glittens! Can be knit with cable as pattern shows or plain.

Materials: 284-306 yards DK weight yarn, US size 3 32” circular needles.

### **Dirty Martini**

Dirty Martini is a very easy, comfortable, seamless open cardigan mostly worked flat from the top down, with basic raglan sleeves. The cardigan features an easy color work pattern for lower body, striped sleeves, waist and short-row shaping for the back neck, right and left fronts.

Materials: 855-1155 yards of worsted weight yarn, Size 7 & 8 32" circular needles

Cost: \$35 + materials

### **Mash-up Magic Toe-up Socks**

This customizable pattern is a basic recipe to make great fitting toe-up socks for any size foot and with any weight yarn – knitting two socks at a time, using magic loop technique, and featuring a gusset and heel flap with Eye of Partridge stitch.

Materials: Pattern free on Ravelry. Approximately 400-450 yards of yarn (whatever weight you prefer), 40" circular needle appropriately sized for your yarn weight.

### **Bouncing Bunnies Socks**

Be ready for Easter with Bunny socks! Bunnies at the top, on the heel, with Easter eggs on the toes. Includes stranded knitting for the adventurous novice or intermediate knitter.

Materials: 400-450 yards of fingering weight yarn and 50 yards of contrast yarn in same weight, size 2 32" or 40" circular needle.

Cost: \$35 plus materials
